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Dialogues on Youth Friendly Gender- & Diversity-Responsive Sexual & Reproductive Health Education – A German-Kyrgyz Interdisciplinary Project for Capacity Building in Applied Research

The project aims at fostering dialogue and advocacy for sexual and reproductive health education in Kyrgyzstan through capacity building in applied research and community outreach. There is a great necessity for gender-responsive approaches and strategies as well as culturally sensitive approaches in adolescents and youth sexual and reproductive health education and interventions in the country. Young people experience problems getting access to information about sexual and reproductive health and often are not well informed about family planning techniques. Violence against women is pervasive. Furthermore, the countries of Central Asia are confronted with one of the fastest growing HIV/Aids epidemics worldwide. A major strength of the project is the collaboration of the American University of Central Asia (AUCA) geared to impart theoretical knowledge and Kiel University of Applied Sciences focusing on applied research and professional application.
