Project duration: March – June

Kiel University of Applied Sciences plays an important role both in the city and within the region. It attracts and supports incoming and outgoing specialist expertise in a wide range of industries. The Faculty of Business Management with over 1600 undergraduate and approximately 400 postgraduate students is the largest faculty of business administration in Schleswig-Holstein with small classes with highly experientially and academically qualified professors.

What is BPS and how is it organized?

Teams of international students work on a real-time project in a local company, supervised by a professor of the Faculty of Business Management.

The initial part of the BPS is four weeks of classroombased (short) courses (in English) covering hard and soft skills, including project management, process management, supply chain management, market research, teambuilding, conflict management and business behaviour.

Tuition is a mixture of classic, interactive-discussive as well as workshop style. Supervisory tutorials and courses will also take place during the project part of the program.

Successful completion of the BPS will achieve 30 ECTS points, of which 20 are for the project, 5 for the introductory courses and 5 for an additional course of your choice.

Participation is open to undergraduate students of Business Administration, Industrial Engineering and IT-Business. The number of participants is limited.

Past Project Examples:

Developing an Internationalisation Strategy for a provider of engineering services. Specifically, students analysed the market environment in Denmark, its suitability for an expansion and possible internationalisation paths.

Developing a Marketing Strategy for the organisers of an Open Air Festival with 80,000 visitors. The project included a survey of current visitors, an analysis of social media activities and a customer profiling analysis.
